RE: Review of Police Related Shooting of Michael Johnson

Dear State's Attorney Foxx:

Pursuant to your request, this Agency has thoroughly reviewed the evidence provided to us by your Office in the above matter.

Our goal was to address whether the fatal shooting of Mr. Michael Johnson on May 9, 2016, by Chicago Police Officers John Clark #18361, warranted the filing of criminal charges, and whether the evidence was sufficient to overrule the declination of charges previously submitted by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office on or about May 10, 2017, and formally closed on May 18, 2017.

Based upon a comprehensive and independent evaluation of the information provided, we find that the decision by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office to decline prosecution is consistent with the evidence. This finding is strictly limited to the conclusion as to criminal charges and makes no determination regarding the existence of any administrative violations or the potentiality of civil liability.
